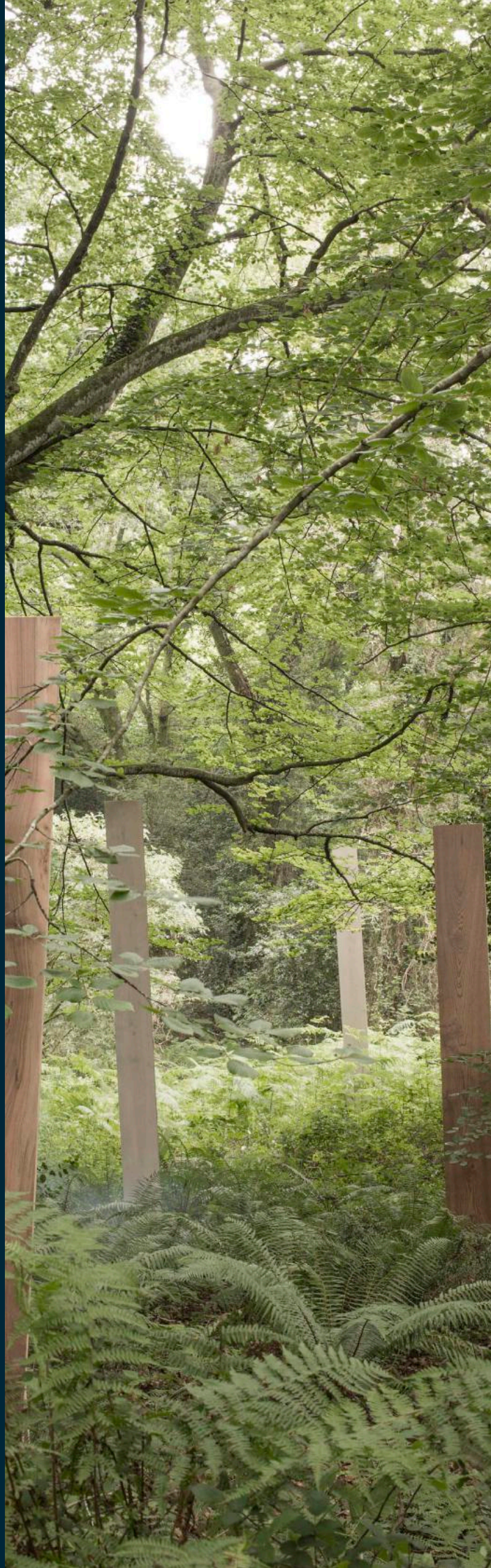

PREFINISHED ENGINEERED FLOORING INSTALLATION GUIDE



The following instructions comply with all recommendations as outlined in Installation Guidelines and Methods published by the National Wood Flooring Association (NWFA).

For a correct installation of the floor it is necessary to comply with the following conditions published by the National Wood Flooring Association (NWFA).

Before installation

It is the responsibility of the installer/owner to determine if the jobsite conditions are environmentally acceptable and the sub-floor system is acceptable for the installation of wood flooring.

Inspect all materials carefully before installation.

Warranties do not cover materials with visible defects once they are installed.

Note: Do not apply/use tape of any kind to the surface of Grato Parquet prefinished floors

After Installation

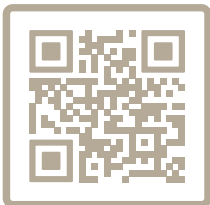
Grato Parquet declines any responsibility for wood floor failures or problems associated with or resulting from sub-floor/sub-surface structural or environmental deficiencies or jobsite damage after the hardwood flooring has been installed.

It is the responsibility of the installer/owner to condition and maintain site conditions in the environmentally acceptable range for the life of the wood floor.

Special Notes concerning Infloor Radiant Heat:

The heating system should be run at 2/3 of maximum output for a minimum of 2 weeks to allow any remaining moisture to evaporate, attaining its final moisture content without causing damage. Three or four days before installation, the heating system must be reduced to a suitable temperature (about 18c/64f).

Approximately 2 days after installation is complete, gradually (over a period of 1 week) raise the temperature of the heating system to its desired operating level.
